CONVERSATION GUIDE

WEEK 2

BOTTOM LINE: Advent reminds us of the awesome things that Jesus brought when He came to earth.

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Bibles
- Student Notebooks
- Candles - 3 purple, 1 pink, 1 white (provided)
- Matches (provided)



hear from God through His word.

DO THIS: Read Luke 2:8-15 as a group and lead your students in a conversation about Jesus' birth using the questions below.

- Tell your students to open their Bibles to Luke 2:8-15 and ask someone to read it out loud for the group.
- **ASK:** *What event is this passage talking about?*
- **ASK:** *What does Jesus' birth bring to the world?*

experience Advent as a group.

DO THIS: Explain the tradition of Advent to your students using the **candles** from your series kit and the questions and prayer prompts below.

- Light one of the **purple candles** and explain that this candle represents **HOPE**. It reveals the hope that we have in Jesus because He came to earth to save us from our sins.
- **ASK:** *What does it mean to have hope?*
- **ASK:** *How does Jesus' birth bring hope to the world?*

★ **PRAY:** Ask a student to pray and thank Jesus for the hope that He brings us and the world.

- Light another **purple candle** and explain that this candle represents **PEACE**. It reveals the peace that Jesus brought about when He arrived on earth.
- **ASK:** *How does Jesus' birth bring peace to the world?*
- **ASK:** *Why do you think Jesus wants us to have peace?*

★ **PRAY:** Ask a student to pray for peace in the midst of the busy Advent season.

say this:
Advent is a church tradition that involves lighting five different candles. Each candle represents a unique meaning.



- Light the **pink candle** and explain that this candle represents **JOY**. It reveals the joy that we have knowing that Jesus came to earth to save us. It's a reminder of the joy we experience knowing that we are saved.
- **ASK:** *What does it mean to have joy?*
- **ASK:** *How does Jesus' birth bring joy to the world?*
 - ✦ **PRAY:** Ask a student to pray that everyone in your group will experience joy in the weeks leading up to Christmas.
- Light the last **purple candle** and explain that this candle represents **LOVE**. It reveals the love that Jesus has for you. Jesus came to earth to be the ultimate example of love and express that Love through the cross.
- **ASK:** *How does Jesus' birth bring love to the world?*
- **ASK:** *How does knowing Jesus loves you change the way you view yourself and the people around you?*
 - ✦ **PRAY:** Ask a student to pray that Jesus' love would be felt by every person in this group.
- Light the **white candle** and explain that this candle is called the "**Christ Candle**". It reveals the purity of Christ, in that, He lived a perfect, blameless life. This candle is lit on Christmas Day as the final Advent celebration.
- **ASK:** *What does it mean that Jesus lived a perfect life?*
- **ASK:** *How can you make Jesus the center of the Advent season?*
 - ✦ **PRAY:** Ask a student to pray that everyone in the group would be able to keep their focus on Jesus in the midst of the busyness of the Christmas season.
