Here are some options for out-of-group discipleship throughout this series. Deciding how many and which options to complete with your group is totally up to you, but these are some starting points for encouraging your students to continue growing in their relationship with Jesus throughout this series.

G.O.A.T. devotional

One way that you can continue to help your students grow in their relationship with Jesus is by reading the Bible together. We've included a six-day **G.O.A.T. Devotional** that you can do together with your students. Type out or take a picture and text out each day of the devotional to your students. This is a great way to continue conversations from Life Group and to connect throughout the week!

bible project video: john

We read several passages from the book of John throughout the G.O.A.T. series. Send out this Bible Project video about John during the week to give your students some context for what you'll be talking about in Life Group.
