Getting to know each other

This lesson is designed to give your students some basic starting points for sharing about themselves. There will be lessons and activities that help you dive deeper in future lessons, so it is ok to keep this week fun and lighthearted. **Students will need to bring things to share this week, so send out a reminder email or text!**

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- 4 personal items that describe you

Ideas:

Bring one item that represents your personality

Bring one item that tell us what your family is like

Bring one item that describes your favorite thing to do

Bring one item that represents your relationship with God/your spiritual life OR bring any item you want that represents you!

GROUP ACTIVITY:

When your group comes together, each person in your small group will share their items with the group. You, as the leader, might want to start or give some examples to get your students thinking. Encourage your students to ask questions about each other's items.

Questions that they can ask:

What's your favorite thing about your personality?

What's a fun memory you have with your family?

Why do you love about the sport you play?

How long have you known your best friend/how did you meet?

GROUP QUESTIONS:

- What are some ways we can continue to get to know each other as a Life Group this year?
- Why is it important for our group to know each other on a deeper level?

PRAY TOGETHER!

Break up into groups of 2 and pray for one another. Have students write a prayer request on a notecard to give to their partner and have them pray for each other throughout the week.
